

Preschool Benchmarks

Classroom:

Early 2s to 3s will be introduced to preschool. At this age children are learning to control their bodies. They practice sitting quietly and respectfully during circle time and during independent activities. Children begin to work on peer engagement and emotional expression. They are working on toilet training and identifying their needs. Children are introduced to the Learning Goals.

Late 3s to early 5s will transition to become Kindergarten ready. The children work on letter cognition skills, fine motor skills, and early literacy. They have improved social skills and can identify their feelings. Children are moving towards proficiency in the Learning Goals by Preschool Promotion.
